Ambassador Job Description

Desired Qualifications for Ambassadors

- ◆ Walks, bikes, and/or takes the bus to get around and has the ability to learn and follow all biking and walking rules
- ◆ Outgoing people person who works well with others and is comfortable talking in front of groups
- ◆ Self-starter with solid work ethic who can commit to class and meeting schedule
- ◆ Possesses a passion for building community and is connected to people and/or organizations in the neighborhood
- ◆ Knowledgeable about New Orleans, and especially any Claiborne Corridor neighborhoods (i.e. 7th Ward, Treme, Tulane/Gravier, Iberville, CBD, Central City, Broadmoor, Milan, etc.)

- ◆ People from communities of color and low-income communities are especially encouraged to apply
- ◆ People are also encouraged to apply in small teams (2-3) with pre-existing community relationships

Training Program & Demonstration Project Timeline

Successful applicants will be available and committed to the following:

- Thursday, June 2 to Thursday, August 4
 - Thursday evening training sessions from 6pm - 8pm
- Monday, August 8 to Friday, September 16
 - Approximately 4 hours per week to conduct demonstration project

Compensation

Ambassadors will receive a \$200 stipend upon completion of the training program and a \$240 stipend upon completion of the demonstration project.
