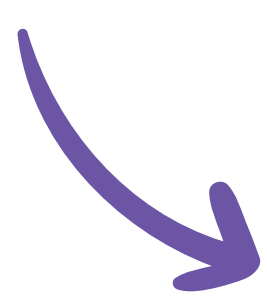

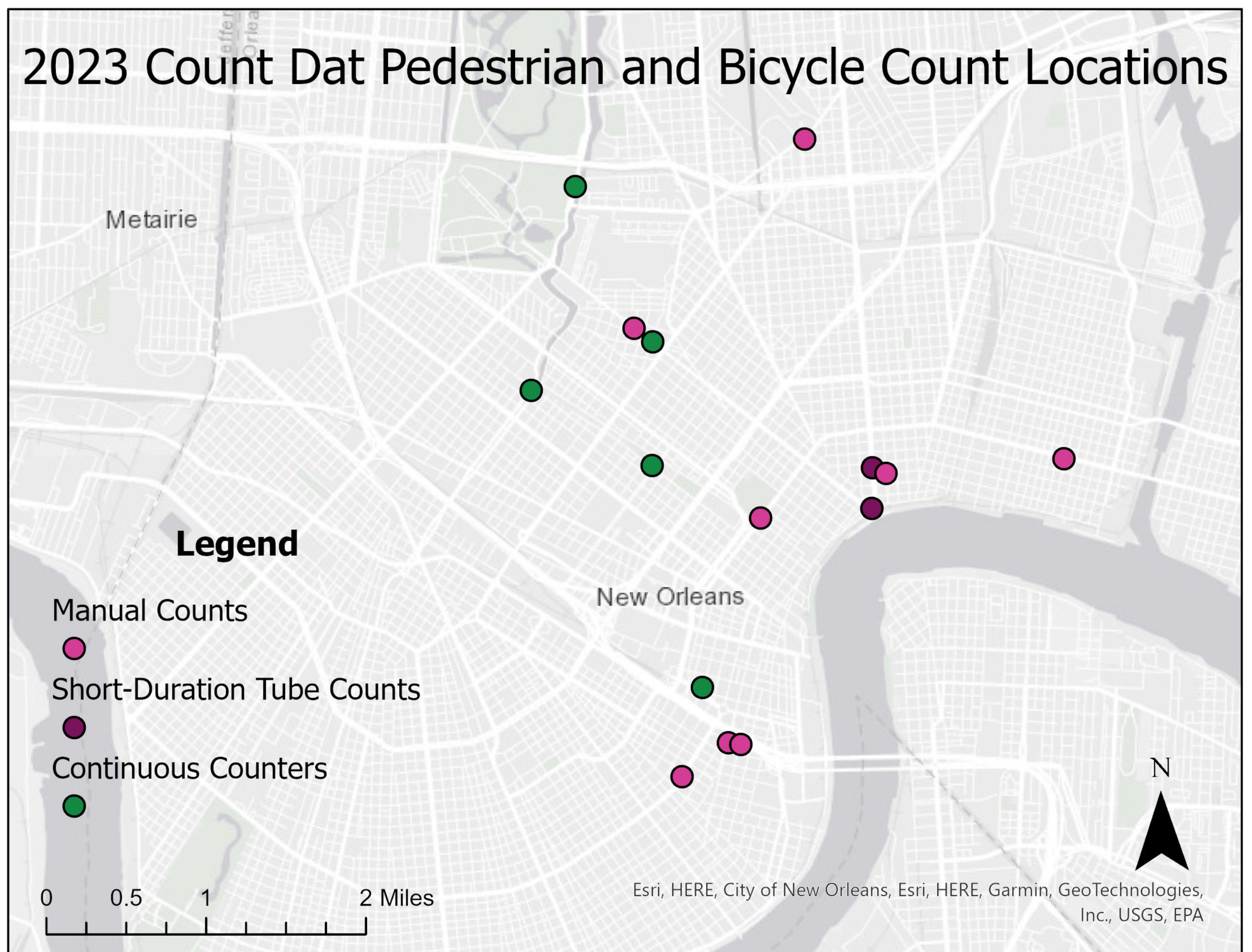

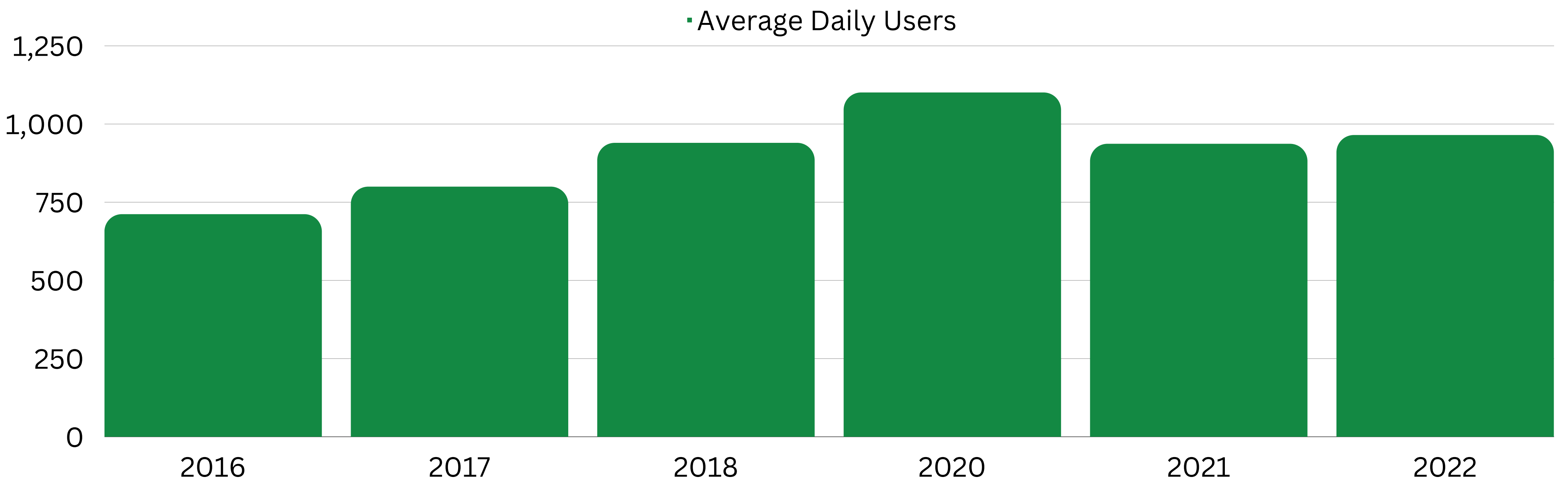

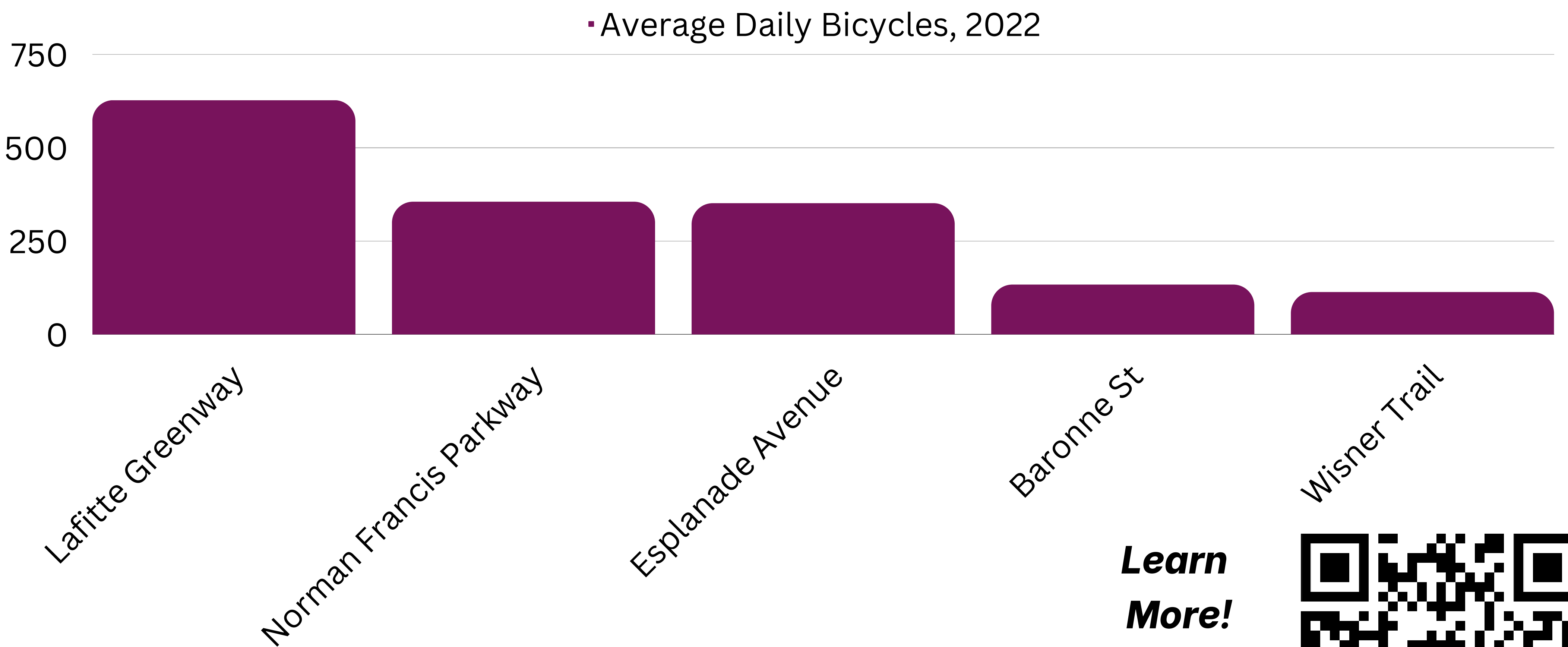
Average Greenway Users Counted: 2016-2022
